

Summary of National Yang-Ming University Foreign Student Admission Regulation

(The following regulations are about applicant status)

1. According to MOE (Ministry of Education) regulations, students who are neither R.O.C. nationals nor overseas Chinese are qualified to study in Taiwan as 'foreign students'.
2. Applicants who have a foreign nationality and have been continuously staying in overseas areas over 6 years are eligible to apply as an foreign students if they do conform to the MOE regulations as following: (8 years are required for those who apply to Bachelor degree of Faculty of Medicine, Dentistry) ※Mainland China Area, Macau and Hong Kong are not included
 - (a) Applicants who have never registered household in the Taiwan Area
 - (b) Applicants who had the R.O.C. nationality before, but when applying he/she has already renounced the R.O.C. nationality over 8 years on which a revocation was issued from the Ministry of the Interior.
 - ※ The eight years period as prescribed above shall be calculated from the date of when the semester begins as set by each individual school.
 - (c) Applicants MUST not be the overseas Chinese students and do not ever accepted an Admission placement offered by University Entrance Committee for Overseas Chinese Students during the relevant academic year.
3. Upon completion of the course of study at the school in the R.O.C. for which a foreign student applied, the student's admission to higher academic levels shall be handled in a manner identical to admissions for local students.
4. Any foreign student who has been withdrawn from a university or a college after admission due to household registration in Taiwan Area or fail on behavior /conduct or school work may not thereafter apply again for admission under these regulations.
5. Foreign students who graduate from foreign national schools located in the R.O.C., or from a bilingual division (program) affiliated with a senior high school in the R.O.C.(include overseas Taipei schools and schools for overseas Chinese), may use the graduation certificate received from such schools to apply for admission to a university or a college.
 - ※In this case, foreign student must comfort to "National Yang-Ming University Foreign Student Admission Regulation", article 2 paragraph 1: "An individual of foreign nationality mentioned in this regulation, who has never held nationality status from the Republic of China ("R.O.C.") and who does not possess an overseas Chinese student status at the time of their application, is qualified to apply for admission under this regulation."

Declaration Form

1. I hereby certify that I do conform to the Foreign Students Admission Regulations Attachment stipulated by NYMU.

The application eligibility is based on "MOE Regulation Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan." If the MOE (Ministry of Education) Regulations were revised, the most updated MOE Regulations shall prevail. 2. I hereby certify that I do not possess an overseas Chinese status and have never registered household in the Taiwan Area.

3. I hereby certify that I do not hold the nationality of Hong Kong, Macau, and Mainland China.

4. All the documents I provide (including my diploma, passport, and other related documents) are valid. If it is discovered that I have violated any university regulation, my admission to NYMU will be canceled, my student status revoked, and no transcript will be issued.

5. I hereby certify that I have not been drop-out/withdrawn from colleges/universities in Taiwan.

6. I hereby certify that if I once held the nationality of Republic of China, I have renounced it for more than 8 years till the date school begins.

7. Foreign students who have already completed in Taiwan the applied degree program or have been expelled from university are not eligible to re-apply for admission. Breaking this rule would result in immediate cancellation of the applicant's admission or the deprivation of the applicant's recognized status as NYMU registered students.

8. I authorize National Yang-Ming University to undertake a verification of the information (including diploma, passport and any photocopies of official documents) I have provided. And if any of it is found to be false after I enter NYMU registered student, I have no objection to be deprived of registered student status.
